

Knitted rug with Crochet Edges



MATERIALS

Panda Magnum 12 ply (100g balls)
Quantity: 17



One pair of 9.00mm knitting needles or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; 7.00mm crochet hook; knitter's needle for sewing seams.

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 110 cm
Length: 154 cm

TENSION

This handknit has been designed at a tension of 12 sts and 15 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 2 strands of yarn worked together and 9.00mm needles. Each square measures 22cm x22cm

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin/ning, **cm** = centimetres, '**crab st**' = work as for dc but working from left to right instead of right to left so that sts are worked backwards, **dc** = double crochet, decreasing, **K** = Knit, **P** = Purl, **patt** = pattern, **rem** = remain/ing, **rep** = repeat, **st/s** = stitch/es; **stocking st** = 1 row knit, 1 row purl, **tog** = together.

NOTE: Use two strands of yarn together throughout.

RUG - Panel 1

Using 9.00mm needles and 2 strands of yarn tog, cast on 29 sts.

Work 7 rows stocking st.

**** 8th Row:** K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Rep last row twice.

Work 7 rows stocking st, beg with a knit row. ******

Rep from ****** to ****** twice. Cast off.

******* With right side facing, using 9.00mm needles and 2 strands of yarn tog, knit up 29 sts evenly along side edge of square (as indicated on diagram).

Work 6 rows stocking st, beg with a purl row.

Rep from ****** to ****** 3 times. Cast off. *******

Rep from ******* to *******, working in numerical order as indicated on Diagram until 14th square has been worked. Join rem seams as indicated on Diagram to form one long panel.

Panel 2

Work as given for panel 1.

Panel 3

Using 9.00mm needles and 2 strands of yarn tog, cast on 29 sts.

Work 7 rows stocking st.

Rep from ****** to ****** as given for Panel 1, 3 times.

Cast off.

Make another 6 squares in this manner, working 7 separate pieces.

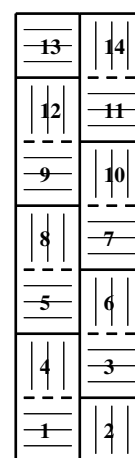
Join these 7 squares to form one long panel alternating direction of squares as illustrated .

TO MAKE UP

Join panels to form rug 5 squares wide and 7 squares long, noting to alternate direction of squares as illustrated. Using a 7.00mm hook and 2 strands of yarn tog, work 2 rounds of dc evenly around all edges, working 3dc in each corner.

Work 1 round '**Crab St**' around all edges.

Fasten off.
