

# Tartan Hot water bottle cover



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## MEASUREMENTS

Finished Hot Water Bottle Cover measures 24 x 35cm.

## MATERIALS

Panda Magnum 8 ply - 100% acrylic (100g balls)  
Red, Black, Green, White, Yellow, Blue 1 each  
One 4.00mm crochet hook or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; knitter's needle for sewing seams.

## TENSION

This item has been designed at a tension of 19 sts (trebles and chain) and 9 rows to 10cm over patt, using 4.00mm hook.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**beg**=begin/ning, **ch**=chain, **ch sp/s**=chain space/s, **cm**=centimetres, **cont**=continue, **dc**=double crochet, **dec**=decrease, decreasing, **fol**=follows, following, **htr**=half treble, **inc**=increase, increasing, **incl**=inclusive, including, **lp/s**=loop/s, **0**=(zero) - no sts, rows or times, **patt**=pattern, **rem**=remain/ing, **rep**=repeat, **sl**=slip, **sl st**=slip st, **sp/s**=space/s, **st/s**=stitch/es, **tog**=together, **tr**=treble, **Base (Foundation) chain**=the length of chain made at the beginning of a piece of crochet as a basis for constructing the fabric, **Turning chain**=one, or more chains, depending upon the length of stitch required, worked at the beginning of a row.

## Hot water bottle cover (make 2 sides alike)

Please note our crochet terminology is English not American. [link to charts](#)

Using 4.00mm hook and red, make 49ch.

**1st Row:** Miss 3ch, 1tr in each of next 2ch, \* 1ch, miss 1ch, 1tr in next ch, rep from \* to last 2ch, 1tr in each of next 2ch ... 21 sps.

**2nd Row:** (1dc, 1ch) in first tr, 1tr in each of next 2tr, \* 1ch, miss 1ch, 1tr in next tr, rep from \* to last 2 sts, 1tr in next tr, 1tr in top of turning ch.

Rep 2nd row 33 times, in stripes of:

1 row red, 1 row blue, 2 rows black, 1 row yellow, 1 row black, 1 row white, 1 row black, 3 rows green, 2 rows red, 1 row black, 1 row red, 1 row white, 1 row red, 1 row black, 2 rows red, 3 rows green, 1 row black, 1 row white, 1 row black, 1 row yellow, 2 rows black, 1 row blue, 3 rows red.

Fasten off.

## TO MAKE UP

Using 4.00mm hook, make lengths of ch (the length of the Hot Water Bottle Cover) as follows:

12 in red, 12 in black, 12 in green, and 6 in white.

Thread ch through spaces across Hot Water Bottle Cover from top to bottom securing at each end in foll order:

1 black, 1 white,

1 black, 3 green, 2 red, 1 black, 1 red, 1 white, 1 red, 1 black, 2 red, 3 green, 1 black, 1 white, 1 black.

Join two sides tog by working through both thicknesses as follows:

Using 4.00mm hook and red, and beg at upper edge, work 2 rows dc along side edge and 8cm along lower edge. Fasten off. Miss 8cm of lower edge, join yarn and work 2 rows dc (through both thicknesses) along last 8cm of lower edge then along other side edge of Cover. Fasten off.

Using 4.00mm hook and red, work 2 rounds dc around opening at lower edge. Fasten off.

Rep around upper edge of Cover.

Using 2 lengths of red 70 cm long, make a twisted cord. Thread through top edge of Cover and tie in a bow.

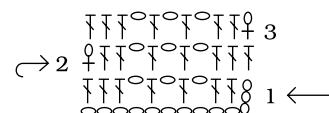
## STITCH DETAIL
